- A detailed inspection of mechanical components
- Full control system functionality check
- · System adjustments where needed
- Visual inspection for leaks and operational issues
- · Small remedial works where needed
- · A full service report detailing all work

PRODUCT WARRANTY

DPT offers a full 1 year warranty on our products for a period of 12 months from the date of invoice.

Upon arrival, your cold booster set will come with a warranty card outlining all terms and conditions.

CHLORINATION
